# The Princess March

*The Princess March* was written to commemorate the 6<sup>th</sup> birthday of the composer's daughter, Jessica Martin. It is composed with simple, expansive harmonies that evoke visions of the procession of royalty through the court. It opens with a dramatic fanfare, followed by a beautiful lyrical section, and concludes with a reprise of the opening fanfare.

This piece is intended for young and developing bands. The harmonies are simple yet interesting, and the changes in density and texture will allow young bands to sound rich and full without significant technical demand.

Steve Martin (ASCAP) is co-owner and Vice-president of Gary P. Gilroy Publications, Inc. which provides works for concert band, string orchestra, percussion ensemble, and competitive marching band. He is currently active as a trumpet player, conductor, composer and clinician throughout the United States, and serves as Associate Conductor and Principal Trumpet for the Reno Wind Symphony from Reno, Nevada.

Dr. Martin holds the Doctorate of Musical Arts in Music Education from Arizona State University, the Master of Musical Arts in Conducting from the University of Nevada, Reno and the Bachelor of Arts in Music Education from California State University, Fresno.

Steve has previously served as a high school band director and California and currently serves as a designer and consultant for high school and university programs across the United States.

Steve has arranged and composed works for a wide variety of genres for nearly 25 years. In 2004, he premiered his first concert band work *High Regard*. In 2005, Steve composed and produced the musical score to the full-length, independent motion picture *Compadres*. He has written for marching, pep, jazz, and concert bands, drum & bugle corps, musical theater and vocal ensemble.

Steve is a member of the College Band Director's National Association, Kappa Kappa Psi, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia. He lives in Reno, Nevada with his wife Lara and two children, Gerry and Jessica.
